## **Basic Staging Techniques**

#1 Attend to the details prior to photographing the home for the listing.

- Garbage cans removed
- · Kitchen counters cleared of dish soap, sponges, excessive small appliances
- Dish towels and pot holders removed from stoves and sinks
- Magnets removed from refrigerators
- Chairs and stools pushed in around tables & tablecloths removed or straightened
- · Lamp shades and pictures on wall straightened
- No dogs or cats in photos and pet beds removed
- Bathroom counters cleared of toothpaste, mouthwash, shampoo and other personal items
- Comforters and bedding straightened, and pillows fluffed. No unmade beds.
- Remove blankets and Afghans from beds and sofas if they do not match or add to the photo; do the same with rugs.
- Coats removed from hooks and chairs
- Deck umbrellas raised or removed
- No vehicles
- No construction debris
- Make sure windows and mirrors are clean
- Depersonalize home by removing family pictures & personal collections; create a neutral canvas
- Purge & Pack purging unwanted items early will save you time and frustration at moving time. Pack up non-essentials and store them.
